24th G7 Speakers' Summit

Thursday 10 to Saturday 12 September 2026

From Thursday 10 to Saturday 12 September, Ms Yaël Braun-Pivet, President of the National Assembly, will host the 24th G7 Speakers' summit bringing together the Speakers of the lower houses of the G7 members, as well as the President of the European Parliament and the Speaker of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine.

The summit is subject to **mandatory special accreditation**. Journalists (including journalists holding permanent accreditation with the National Assembly) must **register with the National Assembly's Press Division by 5 p.m. on Monday 7 September 2026** (Paris time), by email at: presse@assemblee-nationale.fr.

Journalists and their teams must present one of the following documents:

- a valid press card issued by the CCIJP (French Commission for a Professional Identity Card for Journalists);
- a valid correspondent press card issued by the Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs;
- for technicians and non-permanent staff of a media organisation, a letter of assignment from the management of their newsroom (written in French or English), together with a valid national identity card or passport.

The international feed of speeches by Ms Yaël Braun-Pivet, Ms Roberta Metsola and Mr Ruslan Stefanchuk will be transmitted to GLOBECAST (SERTE).

A press workroom (Salle Empire) will be available to journalists on Thursday 10 and Friday 11 September. The journalists' cafeteria will be open on Thursday afternoon and Friday.

Stand-ups and interviews with the participating Speakers will be possible on Friday in the Salle des Pas Perdus.
