### **24th G7 Speakers' Summit**

**Thursday 10 to Saturday 12 September 2026**

Ms Yaël Braun-Pivet, President of the French National Assembly, will host the 24th G7 Speakers' Summit from 10 to 12 September 2026, bringing together the Speakers of the lower houses of Germany, Canada, the United States, Italy, Japan, and the United Kingdom, as well as the President of the European Parliament and the Speaker of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine.

Established in 2001, this high-level parliamentary gathering will provide an in-depth exchange on shared challenges facing our democracies. The G7 Speakers' Summit also serves as an opportunity to reaffirm the common values that bind us, fostering a productive and enriching exchange of experiences.

At a time of global crises and growing public distrust of institutions, the Speakers will explore ways in which parliaments can counter this trend and resist attempts to destabilise our democratic systems.

The Summit's agenda will cover the following topics:

- *Building a vibrant democracy: open Parliament, citizen trust and participation*
- *What role should Parliaments play in foreign and defence policy in a context of global crises?*
- The challenges of artificial intelligence (AI): How can parliaments be best equipped?

The Speakers will also be received by Mr Emmanuel Macron, President of the French Republic.

At the conclusion of their discussions, the Speakers will adopt a joint declaration summarising their conclusions on these three themes. This text will also reflect their shared commitment to supporting Ukraine and achieving a peace solution in the Near and Middle East.
